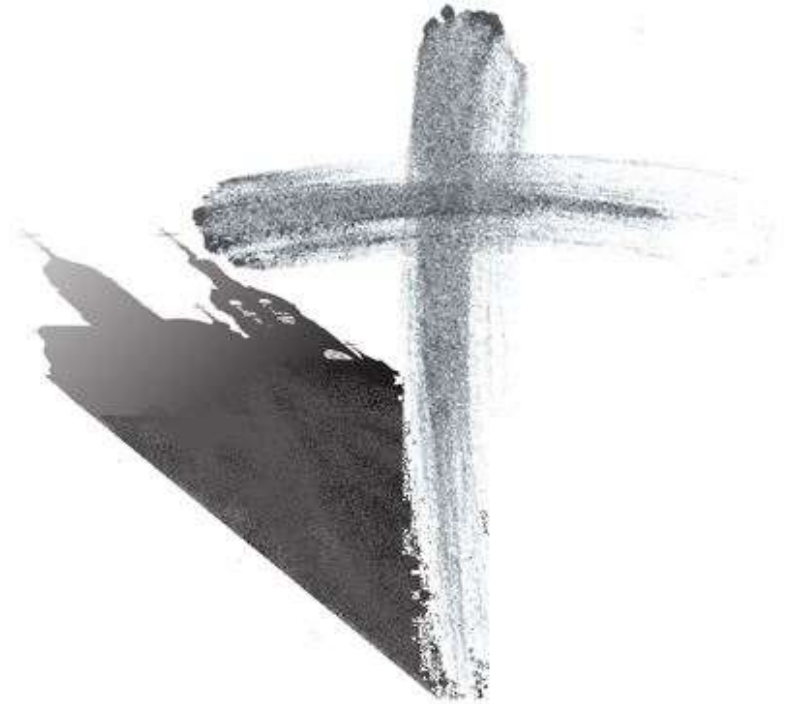

Cunningham Children's Home will host the 15th Annual Festival of Quilts, April 5-6, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., at Cunningham's Spiritual Life Center in Urbana. Cunningham's signature fundraiser, the Festival honors the tradition of the United Methodist Women, and the quilts they have created and donated for more than 124 years for our kids. Each child at Cunningham receives a quilt of their own to wrap them in warmth, safety, and love. Last year, the Festival attracted more than 1,400 visitors and raised more than \$73,000 to help bring hope to hundreds of youth and families.
